Section 3 of the Climate Commitment Act directs Ecology to:

- ➤ TODAY'S TOPIC: Identify overburdened communities that are most impacted by criteria air pollutants
- Expand air quality monitoring of criteria air pollutants in these communities
- Establish standards and strategies for reducing criteria air pollution within these communities

Ground-level Ozone (O₃)

Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂)


Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂)

Carbon Monoxide (CO)

Lead (Pb)




What do we mean by draft indicators?

"Indicators" are:


categories that represent issues related to air quality within communities.

- Examples:
 - Environmental factors
 - Health impacts
 - o Income & race
- Informed by public input
- Measureable

Apply boundary factors


Final list of overburdened

What are the Boundaries of a Community?

Possible Factors:

- Statewide indicators
- Existing community boundaries
- Locations of schools, childcare centers, healthcare facilities, detention centers, etc.
- Local and regional health, pollution, environmental justice studies
- Additional air quality data and tools
- Community size
- Public input




How do we select data?

Does the information represent communities across the state?


Does data exist?

What are the different ways others have put data together?




Environmental Health Disparities Map





Fall Engagement Process – Dates & logistics

Initiative Summary

- New opportunity in Washington to address criteria air pollution in communities most impacted.

 - Expanded air monitoring networks
 - New emission control mechanisms
 - Funding to address criteria air pollution


