# LA Maternal Mental Health Access - LAMMHA ECHO Perinatal Case Conference Series

Funded through the <u>California Health Care Foundation</u>, the LAMMHA ECHO series is a 10-session **CME-accredited**\* and **CE-accredited**\* program for California State providers and mental health professionals who want to improve mental health care for their perinatal patients.

The series will provide evidence-based strategies to treat perinatal mental health conditions in combination with in-depth case presentation and group discussion. Sessions will be facilitated by regional experts and UW psychiatrists and family medicine physicians. The 10-month case series will be offered February – November 2023, 2024.
