## **LAMMHA Additional Information**

- Applications for CoCM implementation support will be accepted on a rolling basis. There will be four cohorts with application end dates based on cohort implementation support periods.
- Selected CoCM sites will receive \$75,000 in total funds over a 24-month support period.
