


## Credible and compassionate health information for teens and young adults.

The Washington State Department of Health (DOH) is launching a new webpage for teens and young adults - <u>Teen Health Hub WA</u>. It's a hub of youth-friendly health information and resources on topics young people want to know about, including:

- Behavioral health
- Primary care
- Navigating the health care system
- Sexual and reproductive health
- Teen dating and violence prevention.

<u>Teen Health Hub WA</u> features easy-to-use links to healthrelated websites and resources. All links and information featured on the webpage are vetted by DOH experts and reviewed by DOH's Youth Advisory Council.
