

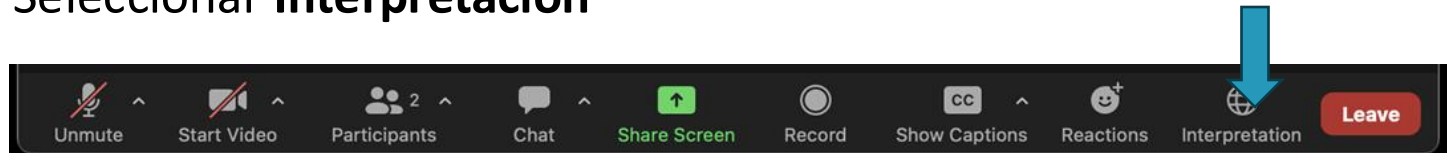

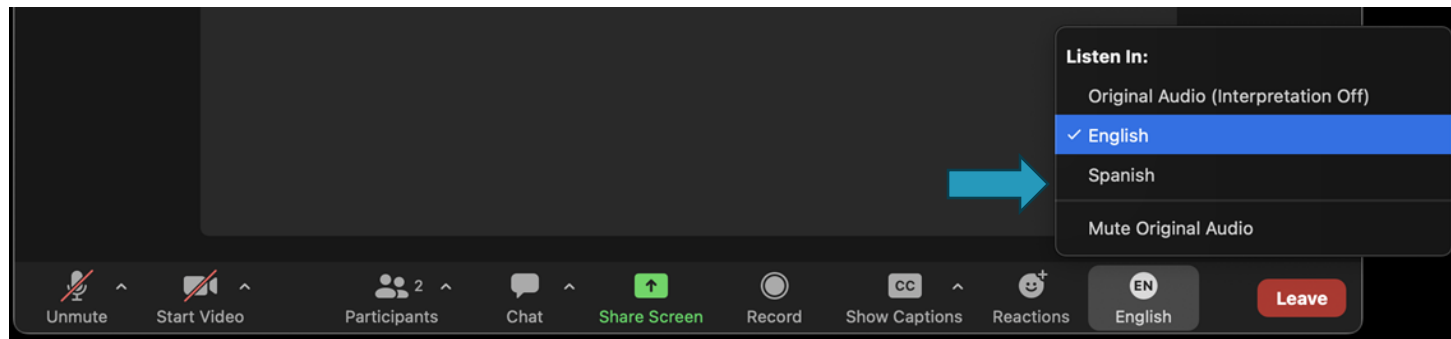

# Reconocimiento de Tierra y Trabajo Parte 1

---

La Community Collaborative quisiera reconocer que actualmente vivimos en los territorios tradicionales del pueblo Coast Salish y otros pueblos nativos que han vivido aquí durante muchas generaciones y que continúan siendo borrados sistemáticamente por políticas y prácticas que eliminan sus historias de este lugar.

Reconocemos y honramos la soberanía de los pueblos indígenas en el continente estadounidense y en los territorios insulares de EE. UU. sobre sus idiomas, culturas y tierras y trabajaremos colectivamente para centrar la humanidad indígena y sus continuas luchas por la justicia en la administración de la salud y el bienestar de sus comunidades.

# Reconocimiento de Tierra y Trabajo Parte 2

También reconocemos que este país ha sido posible gracias al trabajo de los pueblos africanos esclavizados y sus descendientes que sufrieron el horror de la trata, la esclavitud, Jim Crow, el encarcelamiento, la brutalidad policial y muchos otros daños que seguimos viendo hoy a través del sentimiento anti-negro.

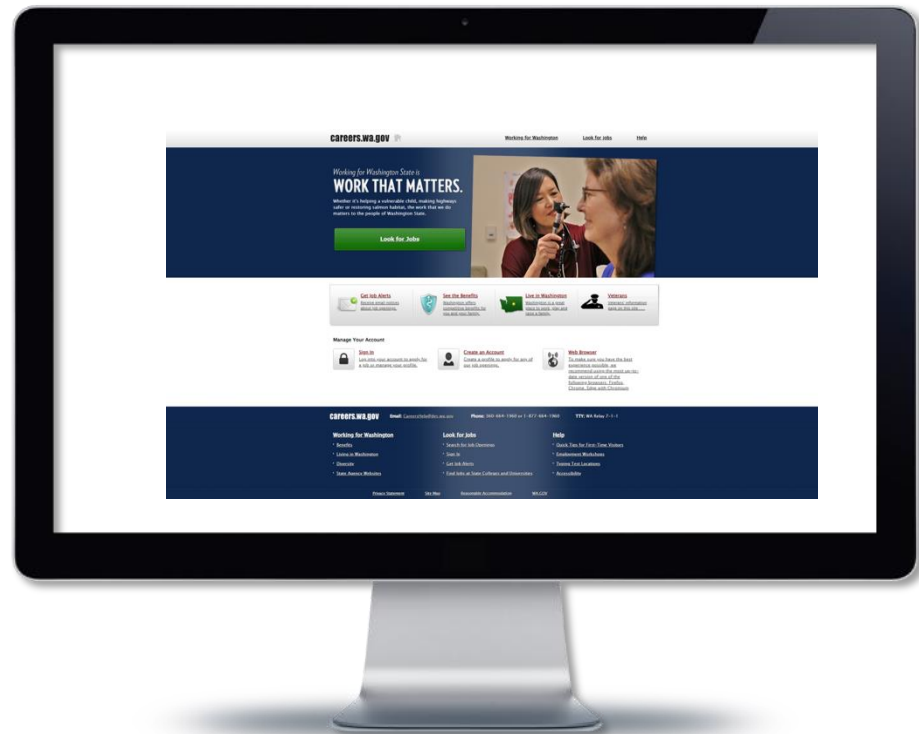
