






Environmental Justice

- Environmental justice means the fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all people regardless of race, color, national origin, or income with respect to the development, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, rules, and policies.
- Environmental justice includes addressing disproportionate environmental and health impacts in all laws, rules, and policies by prioritizing vulnerable populations and overburdened communities, the equitable distribution of resources and benefits, and eliminating harm.

Environmental Justice Council Membership

- 16 Governor Appointed Members
 - 4 Tribal Representatives
 - 7 Community Representatives including a Youth Representative
 - 2 Representatives who are EJ practitioners or academics to serve as EJ experts
 - 1 Representative of a business that is regulated by a covered agency and whose ordinary business are affected by the actions of at least one covered agency
 - 1 Representative of a union representing workers in the building and construction trades
 - 1 At-Large Representative
- 7 Ex Officio Members

Environmental Justice Council Purpose

- Conduit between community and government (e.g. hosting regular public meetings)
- Provide community-centered guidance to agencies on agency obligations
- Provide recommendations to the Legislature and the Governor
- Agency Accountability

Environmental Justice Grants

- HEAL Capacity Grants
- Total of \$26 million dollars with 50% reserved for Tribes
- Applications for Tribes are open until October 31st
- Applications for community-based organizations have closed
- Awarded grants to 6 Tribes and 27 community & Tribalbased organizations
- Five of the awards are for pass through funding
- One time funding

Environmental Justice Grants

- Workplace Safety and Climate Change
- Ongoing funds of \$10 million per biennium
- Supports the administration of a workplace health and safety program for workers who are affected by climate impacts, including but not limited to, extreme heat and cold, wildfire smoke, drought, and flooding
 - Pass through grants to community-based organizations, Tribal governments, and Tribal organizations
 - Procurement and distribution of equipment and resources for workers
- Procured and distributed over \$500,000 in supplies
- Set aside 20% (\$2 million) for Tribes. Applications are now open for Tribal workplace safety grants.

Environmental Justice Grants

- Community Informed Budgeting
- One-time funds total \$38.6 million
 - \$6 million to engage at least 5 geographically diverse overburdened communities in a participatory budgeting process
 - \$32.6 million for grants to selected projects. These projects require legislative approval. 10% (\$3.2 million) set aside for Tribes

5-7 awards to NGOs \$64,943-\$90,920/Years 1 & 2

\$45,895-\$64,253/Years 3 & 4

- Show that at least 60% of proposed activities in your workplan are for direct client services
- Located in areas of the state with minimal overdose prevention resources and services available
- Demonstrate a history of existing relationships with the populations of focus

2024-25 COVID-19 Vaccination Recommendations

- Everyone 6 months and older is recommended to receive a single 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine dose.
- Moderna (mRNA), Pfizer (mRNA), & Novavax (protein based).



COVID-19 Vaccines for Un/Under-Insured Adults for 2024-2025

- CDC is supporting the purchase of COVID-19 vaccine for un- and underinsured adults
- ALL enrolled Adult Vaccine Program (AVP) providers will now have the option to order COVID-19 vaccine.
- AVP COVID-19 vaccine may be administered to BOTH uninsured AND underinsured adults for the 2024-2025 season.
- Pfizer, Moderna, and Novavax vaccines will now be offered through the AVP
- All other vaccines may only be given to uninsured adults.

Flu Vaccine Recommendations

Everyone 6 months and older in the United States, with rare exception, should get an influenza (flu) vaccine every season.

Options for this age group include:

- inactivated influenza vaccine [IIV]
- recombinant influenza vaccine [RIV]
- live attenuated influenza vaccine (LAIV)

People 65 and older should get a higher dose or adjuvanted flu vaccine, including:

- Fluzone High-Dose Trivalent
- Flublok Trivalent
- Fluad Trivalent

RSV Vaccine Recommendations for Older Adults

A single life time dose of any RSV vaccine (Abrysvo, Arexvy, or mResvia) is recommended for:

- Adults age 75 years and older
- Adults age 60-74 years who are at increased risk of severe disease

Older Adults are not limited to seasonal administration and can receive it any time of the year.



mRESVIA (mRNA-1345), approved in May 2024, a 60+ mRNA RSV vaccine

RSV Vaccine Recommendations for Pregnant People & Infants

For pregnant people at 32-36 weeks

- Vaccinate using seasonal administration (September to January in most of US)
- Pfizer RSV Vaccine // Abrysvo

For infants <8 months of age

- Vaccinate shortly before season onset (October)
- For infants born October- March, immunize within 1 week of birth
- Nirsevimab vaccine (1)

For American Indian and Alaska Natives

- Nirsevimab should continue to be offered to American Indian and Alaska Native children aged 8–19 months.
- (1) In jurisdictions with seasonality that differs (e.g. Alaska) providers should follow state, local or territorial guidance on timing of administration.

Co-administration of RSV vaccines and other vaccines

In accordance with General Best Practice Guidelines for Immunization, coadministration of RSV vaccines with other adult vaccines is acceptable.*

This includes giving RSV vaccines simultaneously with seasonal influenza vaccines, COVID-19 vaccines, pneumococcal vaccines, Td/Tdap, and recombinant zoster vaccine (Shingrix).
