

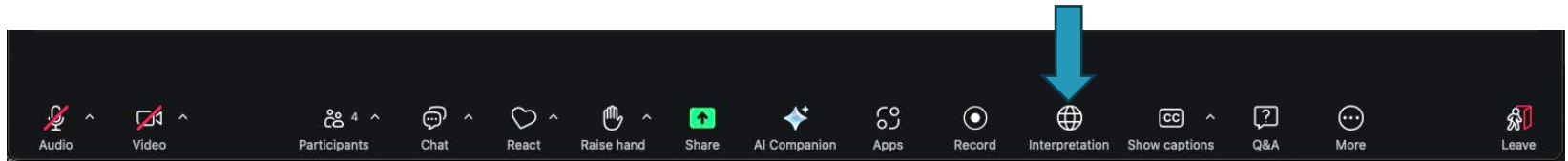

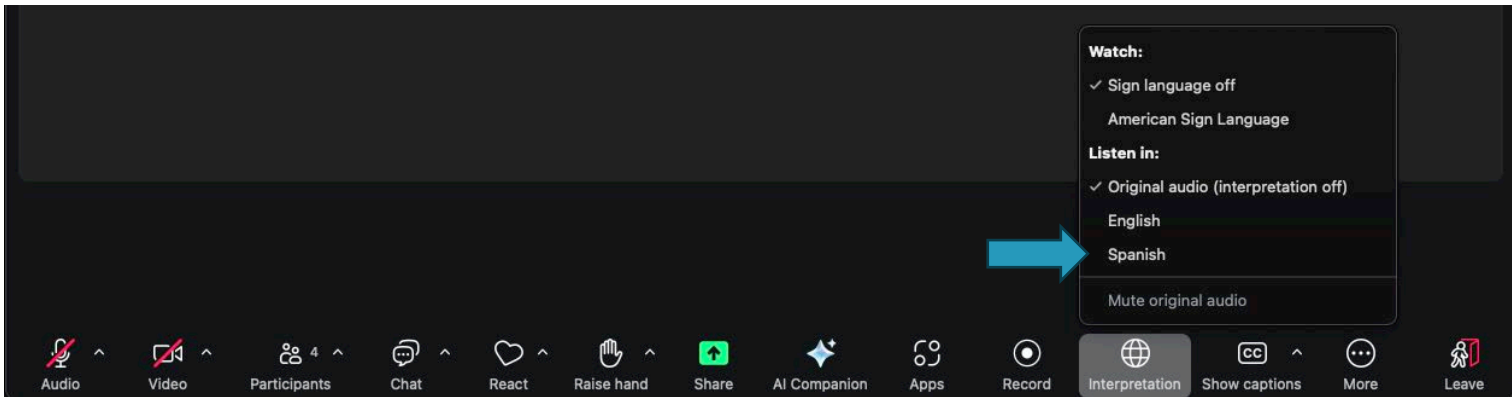

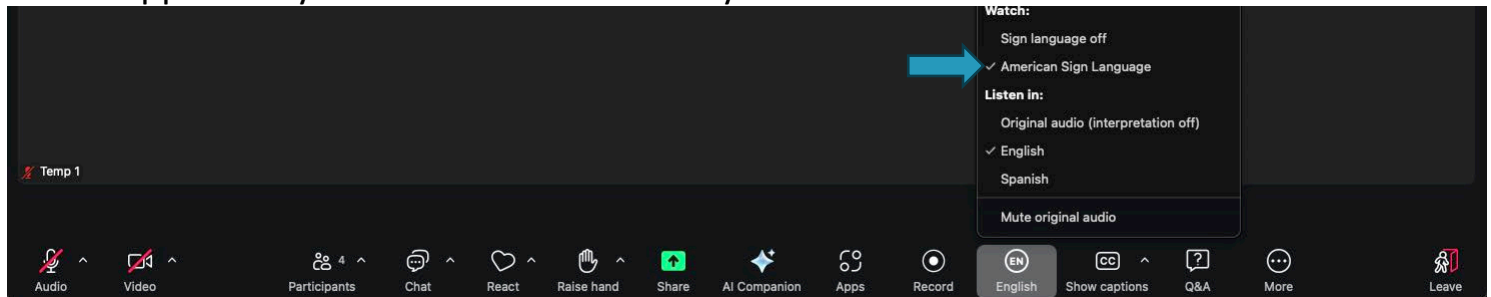

- Choose American Sign Language from the pop up and a floating window will appear on your screen in addition to your main

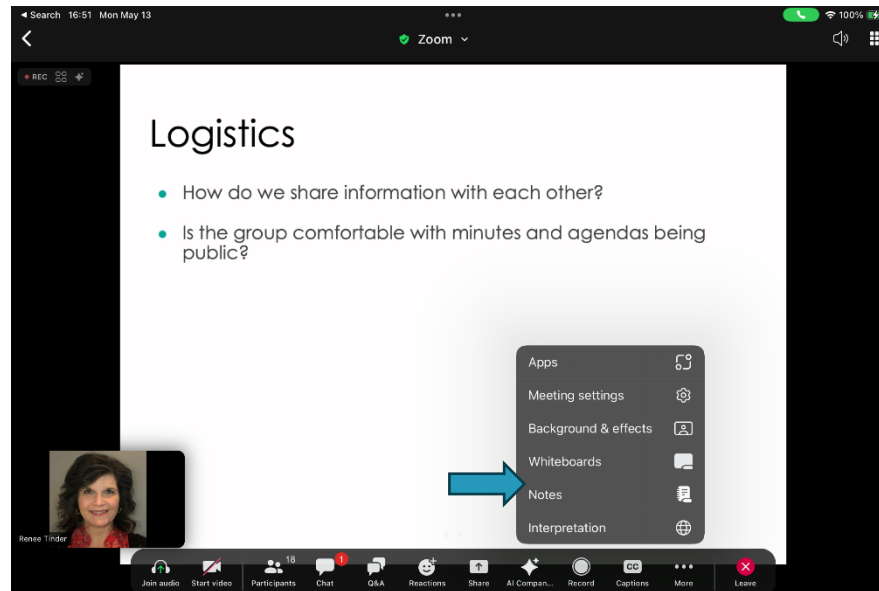

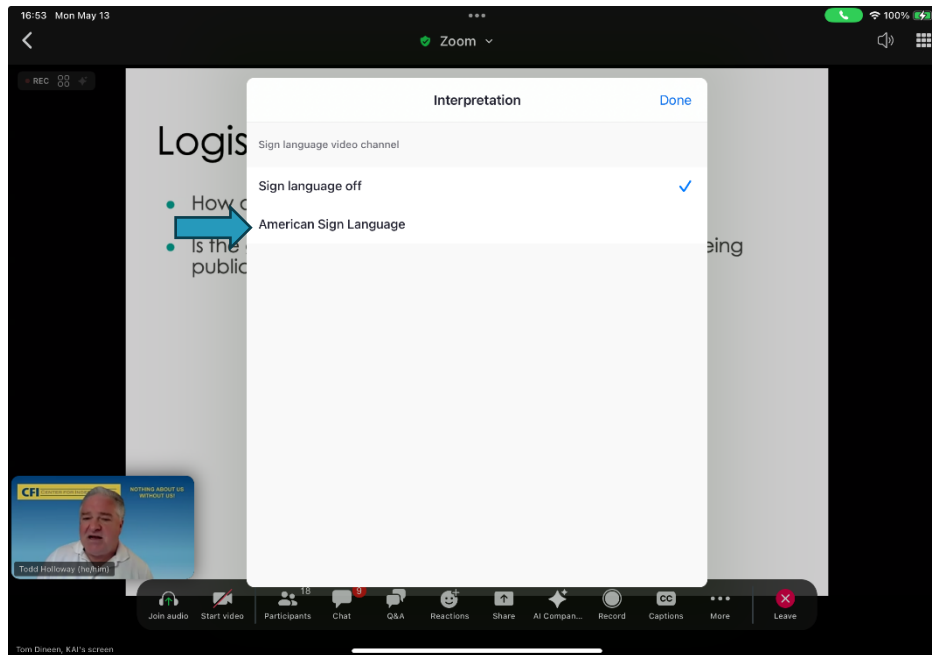
Tablet Device ASL Interpretation

- To view the ASL interpreters on an iPad or other Tablet, click the “More” button at the bottom of your Zoom Application Interface and then select the Interpretation option in the list.



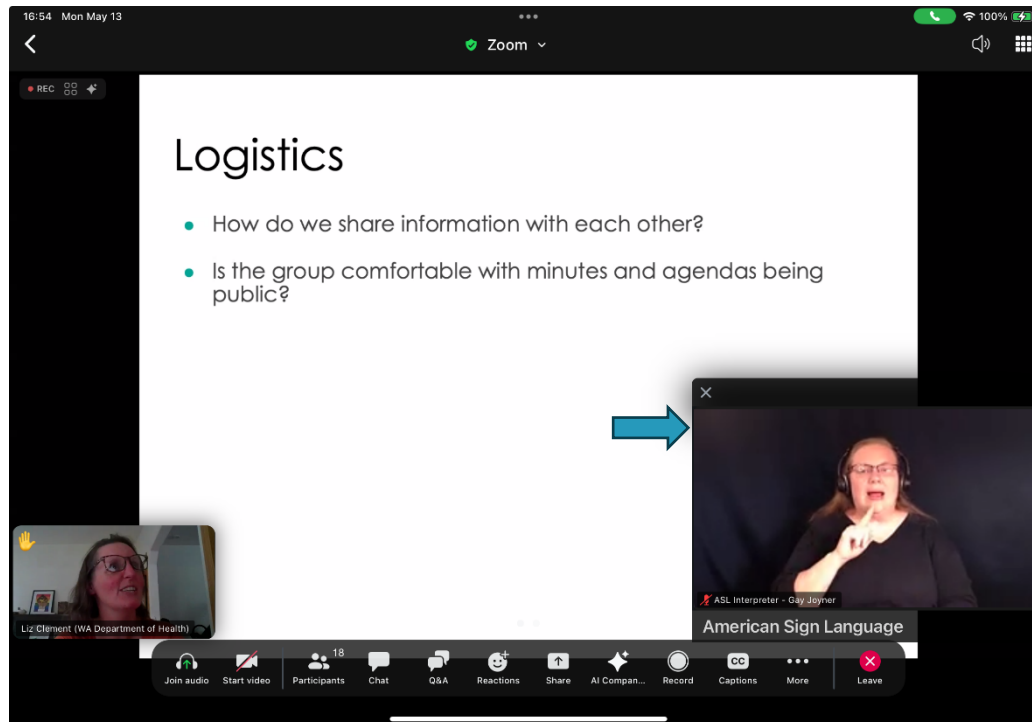

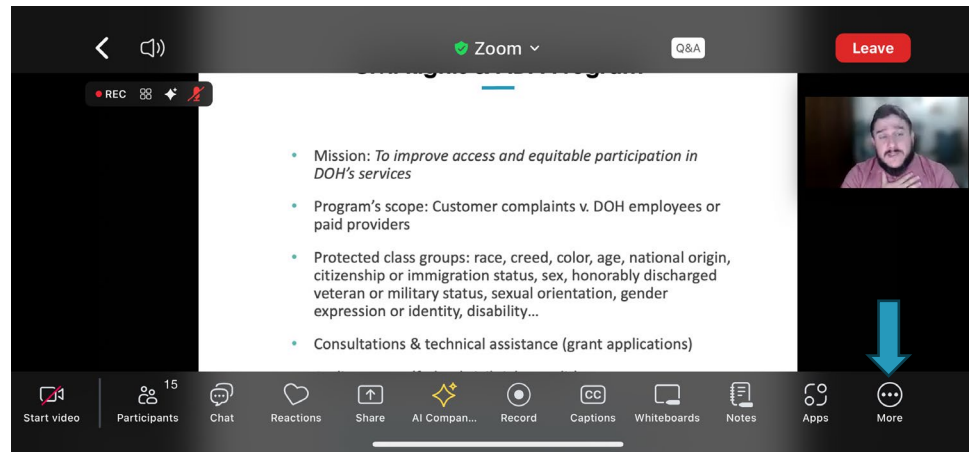

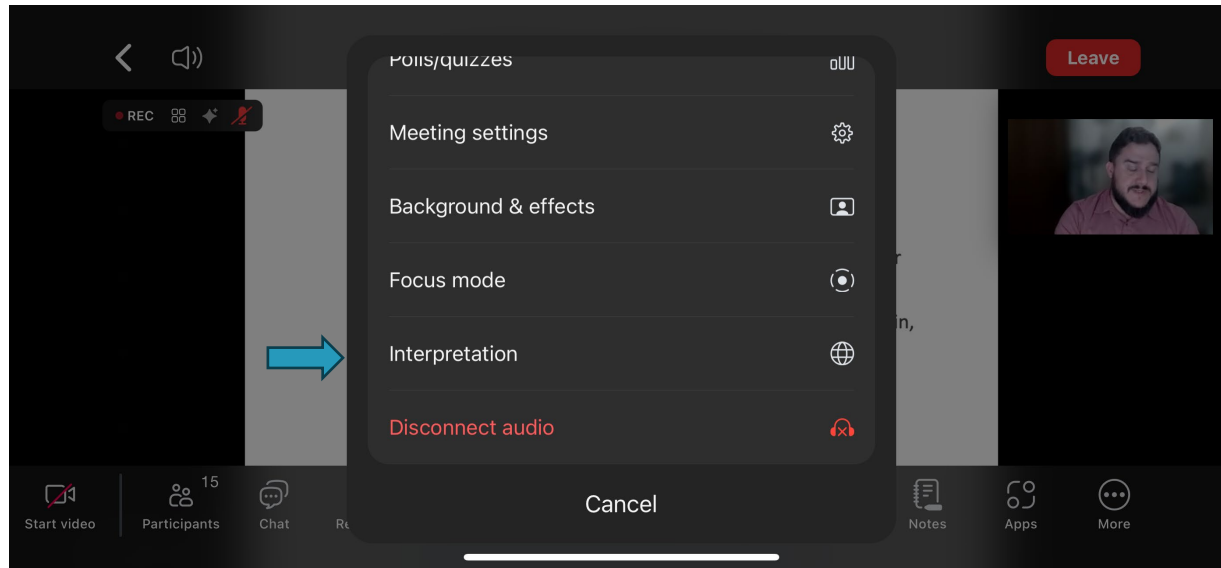
Mobile Phone ASL Interpretation

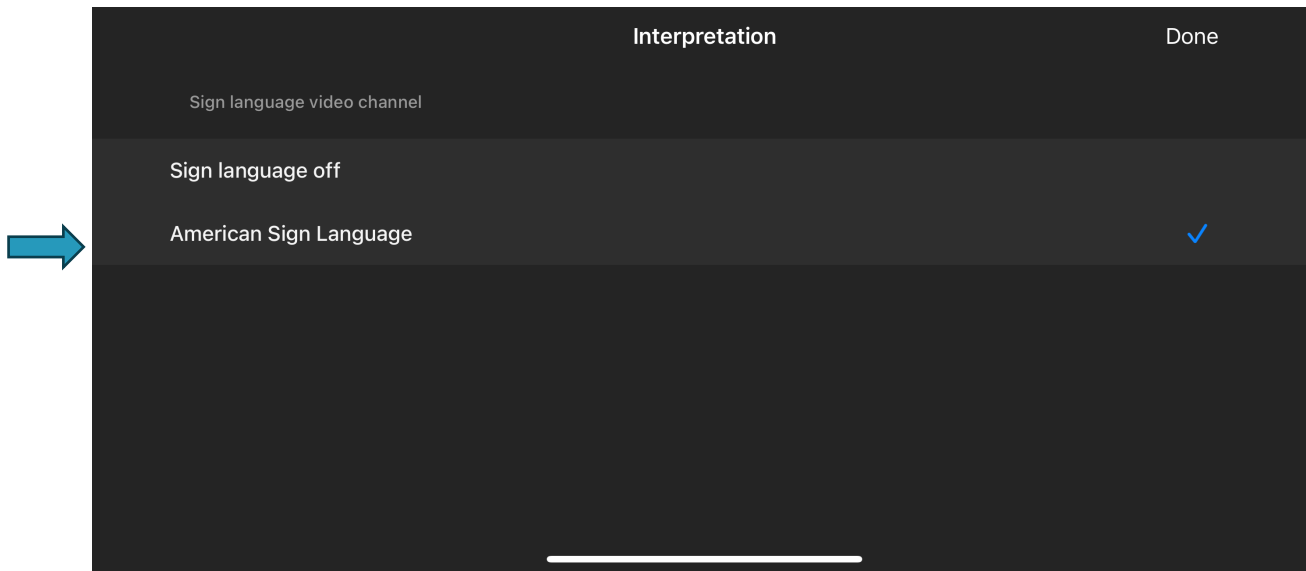

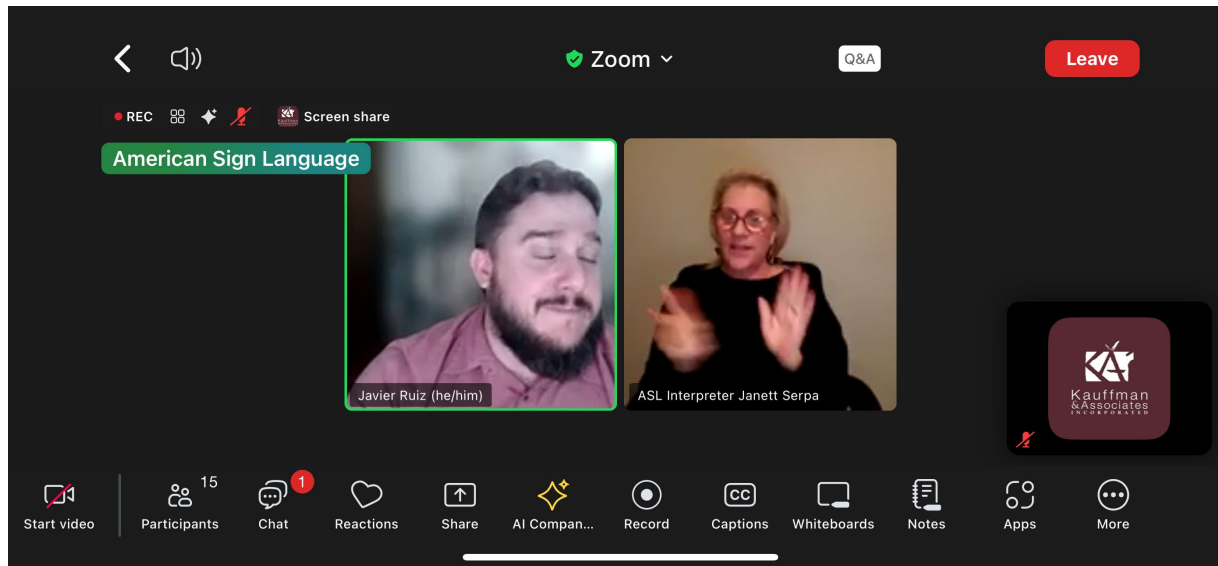

Washington State Legislative Session 2025

Budget Outlook-

- Projected budget shortfall for the four-year outlook \$5-10 Billion
- Contributing factors
- Two Initiatives did not pass 2117 & 2109
- OFM Directive for Budget Exercise
- Revenue Forecast-November 20th
- Governor Inslee's Budget-December
- Federal Budget?



Election Update

- Although we're already a week out from election day, Washington is still counting votes in a number of counties and there are still nearly 225,000 ballots outstanding. The Seattle Times has declared "tight races create suspense" over the balance of power in the Legislature, but the only question is how big the margin of Democrat control will be in the House and Senate.
- Democrats in the House have likely picked up at least one seat in the 26th District, giving them a **super majority** (59-39). Races in the 17th and 18th districts are still too close to call but are trending toward Republicans.
- What is a **super majority**?



Julie Peterson

- In the Senate, Democrat Adrian Cortes is leading Republican Brad Benton by just 230 votes with 96% of the ballots counted. This race appears headed for a recount.
- At this point, it is looking less likely that Democrats will pick up seats in the 10th, 14th and 17th Districts, as Senators Ron Muzzall, Curtis King and Rep. Paul Harris have all expanded their leads since last week. However, if the Democrats prevail in the 18th District, they will also secure the one vote margin needed for a **super majority** (30-19).
- Monday, Senate Democrats elected Sen. Jaime Pedersen as their new majority leader, following the retirement of Sen. Andy Billig from Spokane. Pedersen has represented the 43rd district in the Legislature since 2006.
- Senator Patty Kuderer (Bellevue), Senator Emily Randall (Bremerton), and Senator Karen Keiser (Des Moines) appoints for their seats

The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for **W**omen, **I**nfants and **C**hildren

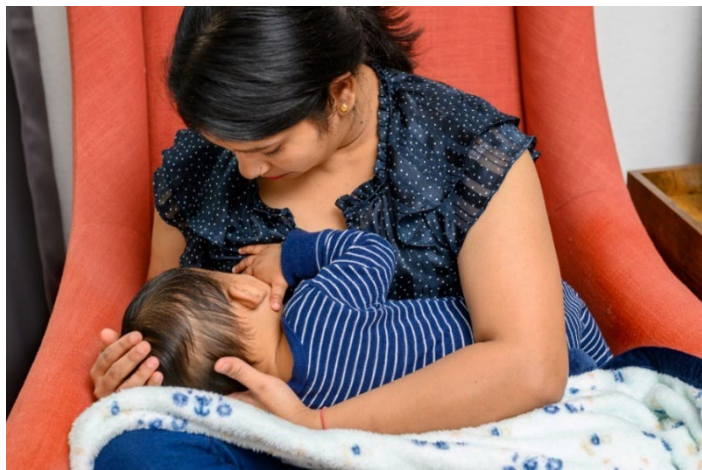
WIC participants are:

- pregnant, breast/chest feeding or postpartum individuals
- Infants age 0-1 and children up to age 5

- Infantes entre 0 a 1 años y niños hasta 5 años de edad.

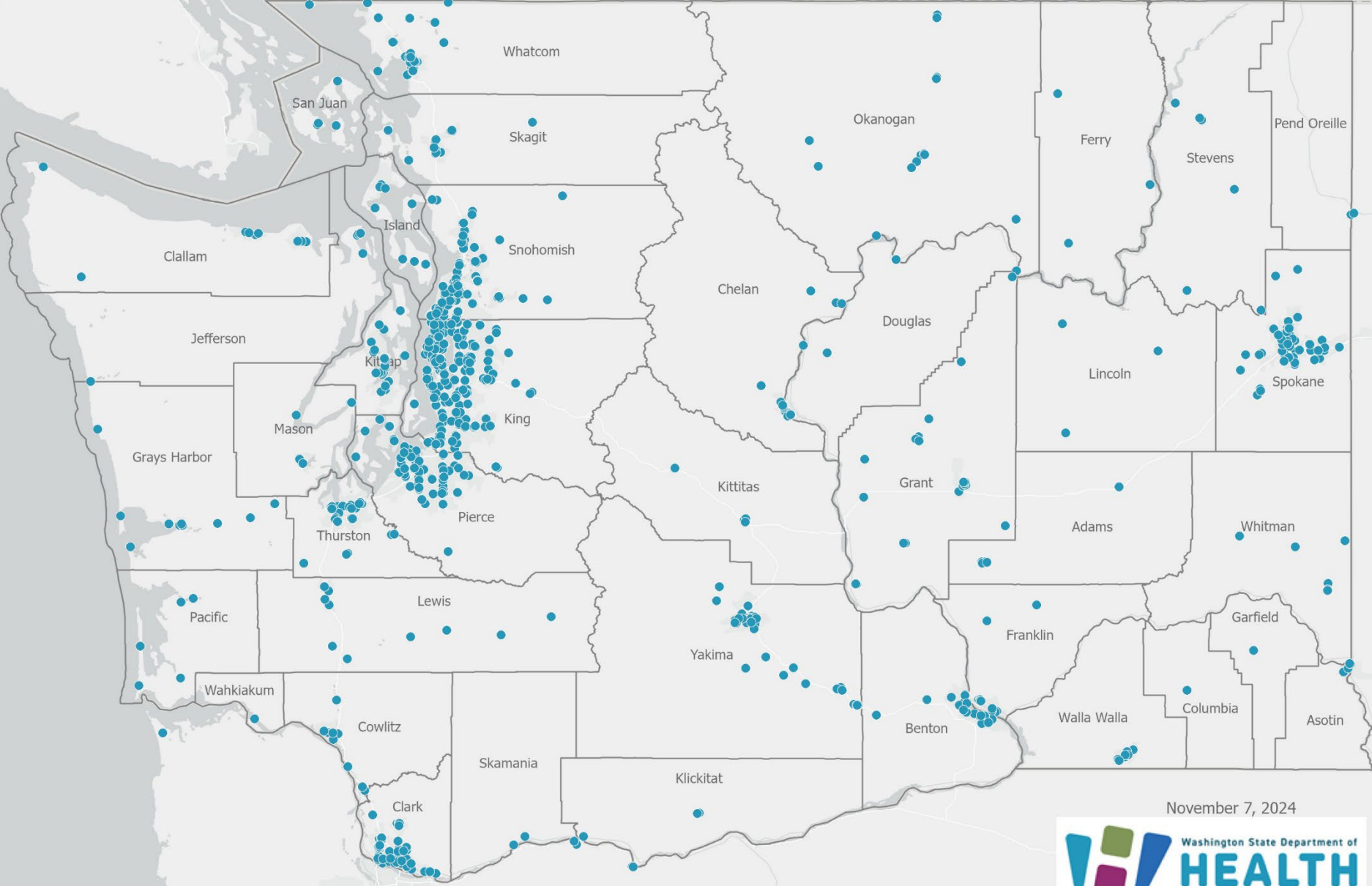

Washington WIC

- 195,655 women, infants, and children were served by WIC in 2022
- 43% of all babies in WA are on WIC
- El programa WIC le ofreció apoyo a 195.655 mujeres, infantes y niños en el año 2022.
- 43% de todos los bebés en WA reciben los servicios del programa WIC

Food & WIC EBT Card

- People receive around \$60 for healthy foods per participant per month
- More than a third is for fruits and veggies
- Las personas reciben alrededor de \$60 para los alimentos saludables por participante cada mes.
- Más de un tercio es para frutas y verduras



WICShopper App

- Household food benefit balance can be accessed on the app
- Scan for allowed foods
- By end of 2022, 95% of WIC households were using the app
- Puede acceder al balance de los beneficios de alimentos del hogar usando la aplicación
- Escanee los alimentos permitidos
- A fines del 2022, 95% de los hogares del programa WIC usaban la aplicación

SNAP Incentives

● SNAP Market Match – Farmers Markets

- SNAP shoppers matched on SNAP purchases up to \$25/day to purchase of fruits and vegetables

● Equiparar el Mercado con los Mercados de los Agricultores

- Los compradores equipararon las compras del Programa de Asistencia Nutricional Suplementaria (SNAP) de hasta 25 dólares por día para comprar frutas y verduras.



SNAP Incentives

● SNAP Produce Match – Grocery Stores

- SNAP shoppers spend \$10 on fruits and vegetables and receive a \$10 coupon or \$5 discount



● Equiparar los productos agrícolas SNAP con las Tiendas de Comestibles SNAP

- Los compradores SNAP gastan \$10 en frutas y verduras y reciben \$10 en cupones o \$5 en descuento.



Fruit and Vegetable Prescriptions

Prescripciones de frutas y vegetales



Eligibility

- Patient at a participating health center (full list at doh.wa.gov/FVRx)
- Positive food insecurity screening
- Diagnosed or at risk for chronic condition

How it works

- Patient receives \$40-\$80/month in vouchers for fresh, frozen, canned fruits and vegetables without added salt, sugar, fat
- Moving from paper voucher to electronic card benefit in 2025

Eligibilidad

- El paciente en un centro de salud participativo (lista complete disponible en doh.wav.gov/FVRx)
- Evaluación de inseguridad para los alimentos positivos.
- Diagnosticado o en riesgo de sufrir una condición crónica

Como funciona

- El paciente recibe \$40-\$80 por mes en recibos para los productos frescos, congelados, frutas y verduras en lata sin contenido de sal, azúcar y grasas.
- Cambiar los recibos en papel en los beneficios de tarjetas electrónicas en 2025
