You will learn how to correctly capture CPT, HCPCS-II, and ICD-10-CM codes for all services provided, align documentation with cost reporting, and properly bill Medicare, Medicaid, and commercial payers. The training emphasizes primary care, behavioral health, preventive services, risk adjustment, HCCs, and quality programs, while clarifying the differences between clinical documentation, coding, and billing. You will build a shared foundation of knowledge to reduce revenue loss, improve reporting accuracy, and support the financial health of your RHC.

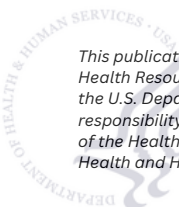
