### Behavioral Health

#### Section I. Core Comprehensive Behavioral Health Service Elements

Comprehensive Primary Behavioral Health Service sites must upload documentation demonstrating that Core Comprehensive Behavioral Health Services are provided on-site; these services cannot be offered in-network, through referral, affiliation, or contract.

#### Section II. Additional Comprehensive Behavioral Health Service Elements (Non-Core Elements)

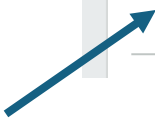
Comprehensive Primary Behavioral Health Service Sites must demonstrate patient access to non-core services (on-site, in-network, referral, affiliation, or contract). Sites must provide proof of access by listing the site name, address, and services provided for entities not offered on-site.

2. Scroll to Section III and begin entering the name, address, and services provided by entities that provide non-core behavioral health services to your clients. This includes entities/organizations who you refer clients to, even if you do not have a formal affiliation agreement with them.

### Section III. Off-Site Behavioral Health Service Details

Under this section, the Comprehensive Primary Behavioral Health Service site must provide basic information for each entity that supports access to non-core behavioral health services.
